Ageing: double Oak wood

EDDU "Grey Rock Brocéliande" honours the most Celtic tradition.

The ageing started in French oak casks, the perfect "cradle" for an ideal ageing, under the mild climate of Brittany.

Then, the final maturation of Grey Rock is done in very rare casks made of Oak trees coming from the mythic forest of BROCELIANDE.

The blend Grey Rock "Brocéliande" got new scents from the hundreds year old oak trees celebrated by the celtic Druides.

Tasting notes

Amber and gold colour.

Exceptional scents of vanilla oak with a touch of broom flower from the Brocéliande oak wood.

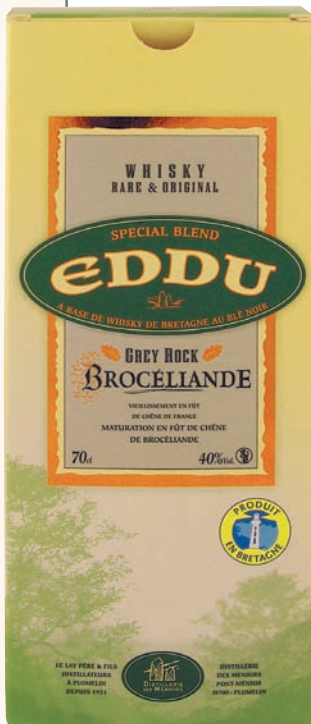
Rich in flowery and fruity aromas of heather honey ; Special scents of forest with a delicate mineral touch.
